

Governments in the region have begun to recognize the immense potential of this natural capital, the ocean, for development of the blue economy.











## TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO'S WEST COAST






Terrestrial Zone T1-Immediate and direct impact area


Terrestrial Zone T2- Area of influence
